2. Make sure you have electronic copies of the following documents:

 - Specimen of your signature
 - Matric and 10+2 certificates
 - Character certificate (issued by the head of the last attended institution, not older than 6 months; original certificate to be attached with the admission form). For gap cases, provide a character certificate from the Panchayat Pradhan/Gazetted Officer along with a self-declaration for the gap period.
 - e-Certificates for categories like SC/ST/PH/Sports/PwD/EWS/WFF/IRDP/ BPL/ Ward of Ex-serviceman/Cultural Certificates, if applicable.
 - Bonafide Certificate for Himachali girls/J&K students.
 - Photocopy of Aadhar Card.
 - Photocopy of bank account number.
 - Migration certificate for students who passed +2 from a board other than HPBOSE Dharamshala.
 - If applicable, provide a single girl child affidavit from the competent authority and a certificate confirming being a single girl child from the SDM/Tehsildaar of the concerned area.
3. All candidates are advised to fill their online admission form on their own mobile phone/laptop, or in the “Lokmitra Kendra / Cyber Cafe” nearby their hometown.
4. Visit the college website (www.govtcollegedehri.org) and access the provided link (<https://admission.govtcollegedehri.org/>).
5. All the candidates are directed to register with their personal mobile number, and email address (as all the future communication will be done by the admission committees using this mobile number and email address only); pay the registration fee; only after paying Registration fee, the candidate will finally be able to start filling the application form.
6. Candidate must save the “Username and Password” generated during registration process with them and complete the admission process by filling the online application form using their own username and password from “Login to Apply” button.

10. At the time of form verification, if admission committee finds any uploaded Photostat documents or documents are not uploaded in the prescribed format, then the admission form will be rejected. Student will be communicated by the committee and also through “SMS and Email” to do the needful changes.
11. Candidate then needs to make the corrections by Logging in their account using their username and password and resubmit the form and wait for final approval which will be intimated through SMS and Email.

Note:

1. Any gap of one year or more in the academic record of an applicant must be accompanied by documentary evidence (self-declaration) demonstrating their activities during the gap period and a new character certificate from a Gazetted officer/Panchayat Pradhan. Providing false documents, self-declarations, or affidavits constitutes a legal offense.
2. PwD applicants seeking a fee concession must provide a status certificate from the Medical Board confirming their disability status.
3. Admission is reserved for students who have passed all subjects in their 10+2 exams from the National Open School (Delhi), subject to meeting the minimum eligibility criteria outlined above.
4. Applicants holding degrees from foreign universities/boards/colleges recognized by the Association of Indian Universities or Himachal Pradesh University are also eligible for admission.
5. Applicants must not exceed 23 years of age (25 years for girls) as of 01-07-2025, with their birth date not earlier than 01-07-2002. The upper age limit is extended to 26 years for SC and ST applicants. However, the Vice Chancellor of H.P.U. Shimla may grant a relaxation of up to six months for over-age applicants.

MIGRATION

Only students with genuine reasons will be considered for migration. Upon migration from another institution, the entire session's funds and tuition fees from the time of joining the College will be charged.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must have passed the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by H.P. Board of School Education or an equivalent examination recognized by H.P.U.

Note: Students with compartment status in their 10+2 exams are not eligible for UG 1st year admission. Admission to UG 1st year is based on merit (percentage of marks/grade obtained in 10+2 examination).

Choosing a Programme/Study Course: Starting from the academic session 2018-19, each student must select a Discipline Specific Course (DSC-I) or Core Course-I (CC-I), Core Course-II (CC-II), Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC), and Compulsory Course or Core Course-III (CC-III) as listed in the table. DSC/CC/Compulsory Courses/DSE/GEC carry six credits each, while AECC & SEC carry four credits each.

For a Degree with a Specific Subject/Faculty: Regular candidates must complete the prescribed course of study in a college affiliated with Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, for a minimum of three academic years. Students starting from the session 2018-19 must accumulate a total of 132 credits over three years (44 credits each year).

Duration (Time Frame): The UG program for regular students spans a minimum of three years and a maximum of five years from the date of admission.

CONTINUOUS COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT (CCA) AND EVALUATION

All courses follow an evaluation system with the following components:

- (i) Term End Examination: A three-hour exam covering the entire syllabus, accounting for 70% of the theory marks for Arts and Commerce (where practicals are not involved). For Science and subjects/courses with practicals, it accounts for 50% of theory marks, 20% of practical marks, and 30% of CCA.
- (ii) Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA): The CCA includes: a) 5 marks for attendance. b) 5 marks for a class test conducted upon completion of 40% of the syllabus. c) 10 marks for a house test conducted upon completion of 75% of the syllabus. d) 10 marks for assignments, tutorials, and general behaviour.

(iii) Classroom Attendance Incentive: Students with attendance greater than 75% receive CCA marks as follows:

75% -< 80% - 1 mark 80% - 85% - 2 marks 85%- 90% - 3 marks 90%-< 95% - 4 marks. 95% and more - 5 marks

Core Courses:

These are of two types:

- (i) Compulsory Core Course such as English/Hindi/Sanskrit
- (ii) Discipline Specific Course - These courses are related to discipline such as English, Hindi, Pol. Science, Economics etc. in BA and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Computer Science in BSc. and Commerce related subjects in the B.Com.

Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC)

These are of two types: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC)-These are EVS and English Communication/Sanskrit.

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)-These courses are designed to provide skill based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands-on-training/Field work so as to increase employability students.

Discipline Specific Elective (DSE): Elective courses offered under main discipline/subject to study referred to as Discipline Specific Elective.

Generic Elective (GE)-Generic Elective courses are those which are not related to subject specific courses. Students in BA final year are expected to choose one of the subjects other than subjects studied during first 2 years.

Note: (a) In case a student doesn't deposit college dues, his/her name will be considered automatically struck-off from the College rolls.

(b) If a student does not claim refundable security deposits within one year of leaving the college his/her claim of refund thereafter shall not be entertained. All the students are advised to pay no money to any officials of the college without proper receipt.

VARIOUS STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES IN THE COLLEGE

- (i) **N.S.S.:** The College hosts two N.S.S. units, fostering leadership, social service, discipline, and patriotism among 200 students. A third of the slots are reserved for girls, emphasizing inclusivity and holistic development.
- (ii) **Rovers & Rangers:** Initiated in 2015-16, Rovers and Rangers train students in leadership and selfless service, aligning with the Bharat Scouts and Guides' ethos of character development and national service.
- (iii) **Red Ribbon Club:** Enabling students to combat AIDS through education and outreach, the Red Ribbon Club engages volunteers in extensive awareness campaigns, targeting both college youth and the wider community.
- (iv) **N.C.C.:** With separate Army wings for boys and girls, the N.C.C. encourages students to join upon admission, promoting discipline and patriotism.
- (v) **Road Safety Club:** Launched in 2022 with 40 members, the club educates society on safe road practices, aiming to reduce accidents and promote responsible behaviour.
- (vi) **Eco Club:** Empowering students to undertake meaningful environmental activities, the Eco Club advocates for sustainable practices and environmental consciousness.
- (vii) **Gender Champion Club:** Addressing gender equality, the club enrolls 12 students annually, fostering awareness and advocacy for gender rights and inclusivity.
- (viii) **Career Guidance, Counselling and Placement Cell:** Guiding students in making informed career decisions, the cell offers counselling and placement opportunities, ensuring students are equipped for evolving job markets and future prospects.

Sports and Cultural Activities

For holistic student development, co-curricular activities are indispensable, complementing classroom learning by engaging the body, mind, and spirit. Our college offers a range of sports such as Badminton, Cricket, Volleyball, Weight-Lifting, and Table-Tennis, fostering physical prowess. Additionally, students can hone their artistic talents and social skills through cultural activities like rangoli making, poster designing, singing, dancing, debates, declamations, poetry, collages, cartooning, and photography. Various clubs and societies, guided by dedicated teachers, facilitate participation and skill enhancement. Encouraged to join at least one club or society, students enrich their personalities through diverse avenues.

Library

The college library houses 10,608 books alongside encyclopedias, reference materials, and periodicals. Students enjoy access during designated hours. Library rules include maintaining silence, carrying ID cards, refraining from marking reference books, and replacing lost or damaged items. Failure to return books incurs a Rs.1/day fine.

Parent-Teacher Association (PTA)

The Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), guided by H.P. Education Code 2001, facilitates vital parent-teacher interaction for college development. Objectives include: revitalizing relationships, fostering a conducive learning environment, integrating elder wisdom for educational enhancement, advocating student-focused initiatives, refining conduct, ensuring transparent communication, providing temporary staffing solutions, and promoting awareness of government educational schemes. Through these endeavors, the PTA bridges stakeholders, promotes holistic education, and addresses challenges within the college community.

College Students Central Association (CSCA):

Elected in accordance with H.P.U. Shimla regulations, the College Students' Central Association (CSCA) plays a pivotal role in maintaining discipline within the college. Moreover, it actively engages students in a myriad of co-curricular activities such as seminars and inter/intra-college functions. By providing a platform for student participation and leadership, the CSCA contributes to the holistic development of individuals within the college community.

College Magazine: 'HIMIKA':

To nurture the creativity of the students the college magazine "**HIMIKA**" is published every year. It has many sections like Hindi, Sanskrit, Pahari, English, Science, Photography and Chronicle. One student editor of each section is also appointed. CODE OF CONDUCT

I. Attendance:

- (i) University exam eligibility requires a minimum 75% lecture attendance.
- (ii) Irregular attendance or continuous absence for 6 days leads to removal from college rolls. Three such instances result in permanent exclusion.
- (iii) Principal holds authority to expel/suspend students for indiscipline/illegal activities.
- (iv) Students causing damage to government property are liable to be fined.
- (v) Prior permission is necessary for recruitment or any off-campus activity.
- (vi) Use of mobile phones on college premises is strictly prohibited by H.P. Govt. directive.

II. Leave Rule:

- (i) Leave applications must be submitted through subject teachers promptly.
- Note: Students participating in Inter-College Competitions must schedule practice/rehearsal before or after classes, prioritizing academic commitments.

III. Library Cum-Identity Card (I-Card):

- Upon fee payment, students receive an I-Card from the College Librarian. It must be signed by the Principal within a week.
- Importance of I-Card for identification during college hours stressed.
- Lost I-Cards require an FIR for duplicate issuance with a fee of Rs. 20.

IV. General Conduct/Discipline Rules:

Breach of discipline includes:

- Possession of drugs/smoking.
- Bringing outsiders.
- Lack of I-Card.
- Ragging.
- Use of head/earphones.
- Misuse of utilities.
- Unauthorized parking.
- Reckless driving/tripling/driving without helmet

**Extract of Himachal Pradesh Educational Institutions
PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT 2009**

2. (c) Ragging means any act, conduct or practice by which dominate power of senior students, former students or outsiders, is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior by other students and includes individual of collective acts or practices which –

- (I) Involve physical or psychological assault or threat or use of force or wrongful confinement or restraint or
- (II) Violate the status, dignity and honour of such students or
- (III) Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self esteem or
- (IV) Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behaviour.

3(i) No person shall practice ragging in any form, within or outside the premises of an educational institution.

(ii) Any person who contravenes the provision of subsection (1) shall, on conviction be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 3 year or with fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees or with both.

6. Every offence under this act shall be cognizable, non –bailable and compoundable with the permission of the court.

7.(i) Any student convicted of an offence under this act shall be expelled from the educational institution.

(ii) Student expelled under Sub – Section (i) or expelled otherwise on account of ragging shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of three years from the date of order of such expulsion.

A WORD TO THE STUDENTS

- Keep Identity Card with you during college hours.
- Read the Notice Board daily.
- Don't bring outsiders to the college.
- Use of mobile phones and head/ear phones is strictly prohibited in college campus.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- Number of seats in all the DSC for admission to first year of BA/B.Sc./B.Com. are fixed. Hence the admission in the DSC is purely on merit basis.
- In UGC/CBCS, minimum marks to pass/qualify the courses is 45% both in theory and in practical if any.
- Minimum credits required to be accumulated for the award of the U.G. degree (pass Course) are 132.
